- Three full time Stirling modules (totals 60 Stirling credits/ 30 ECTS/ 15 US credits)

- Official transcript

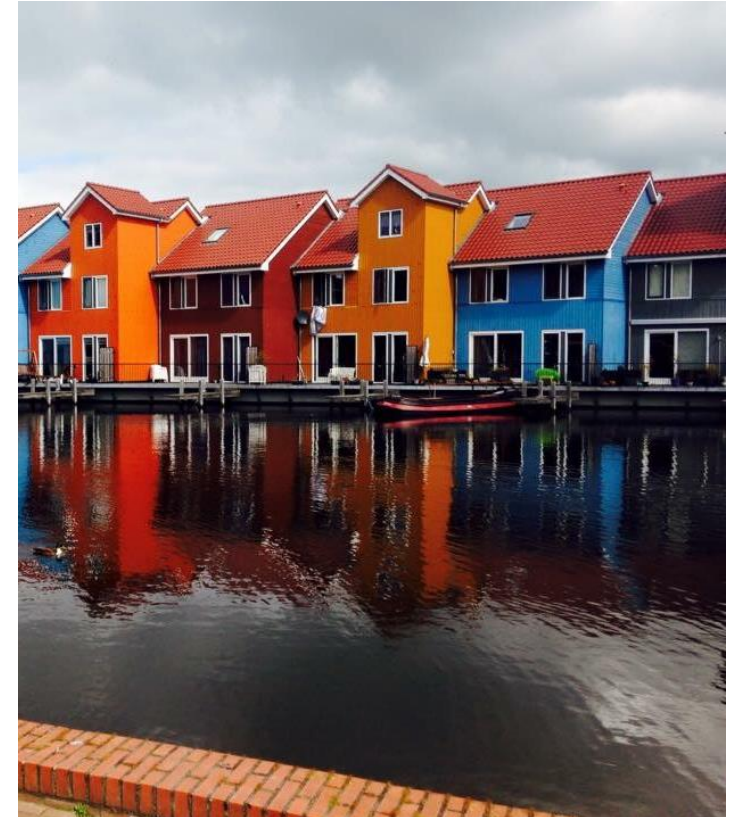

- All other mobilities elective

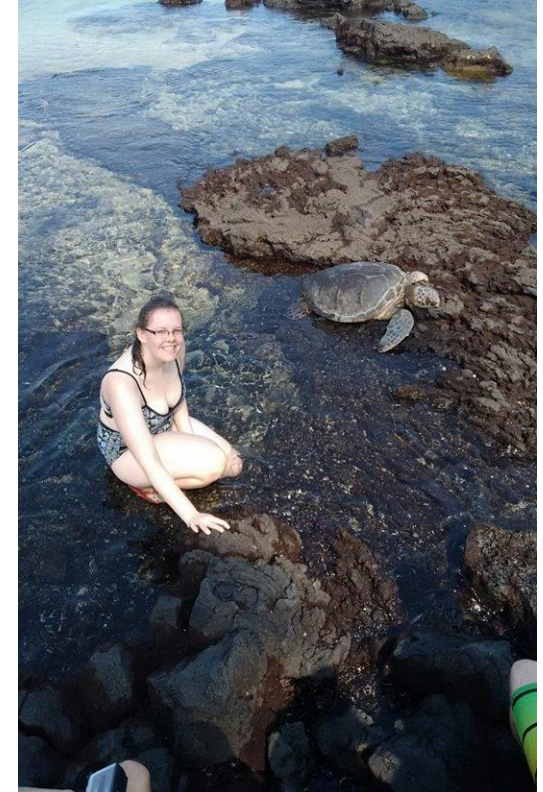


STUDENT MOBILITY

- Arts and Humanities less dominant

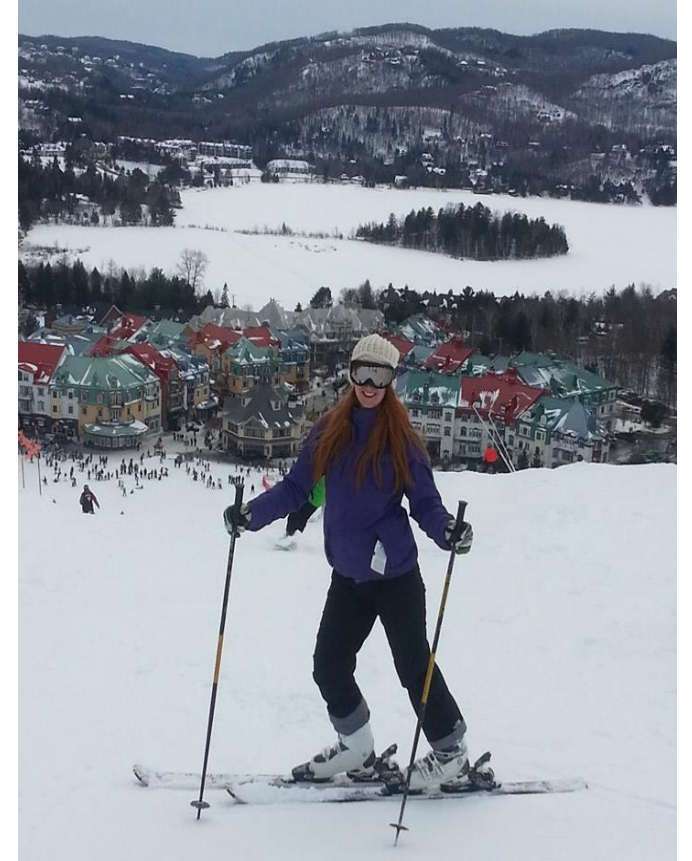


STUDENT MOBILITY
