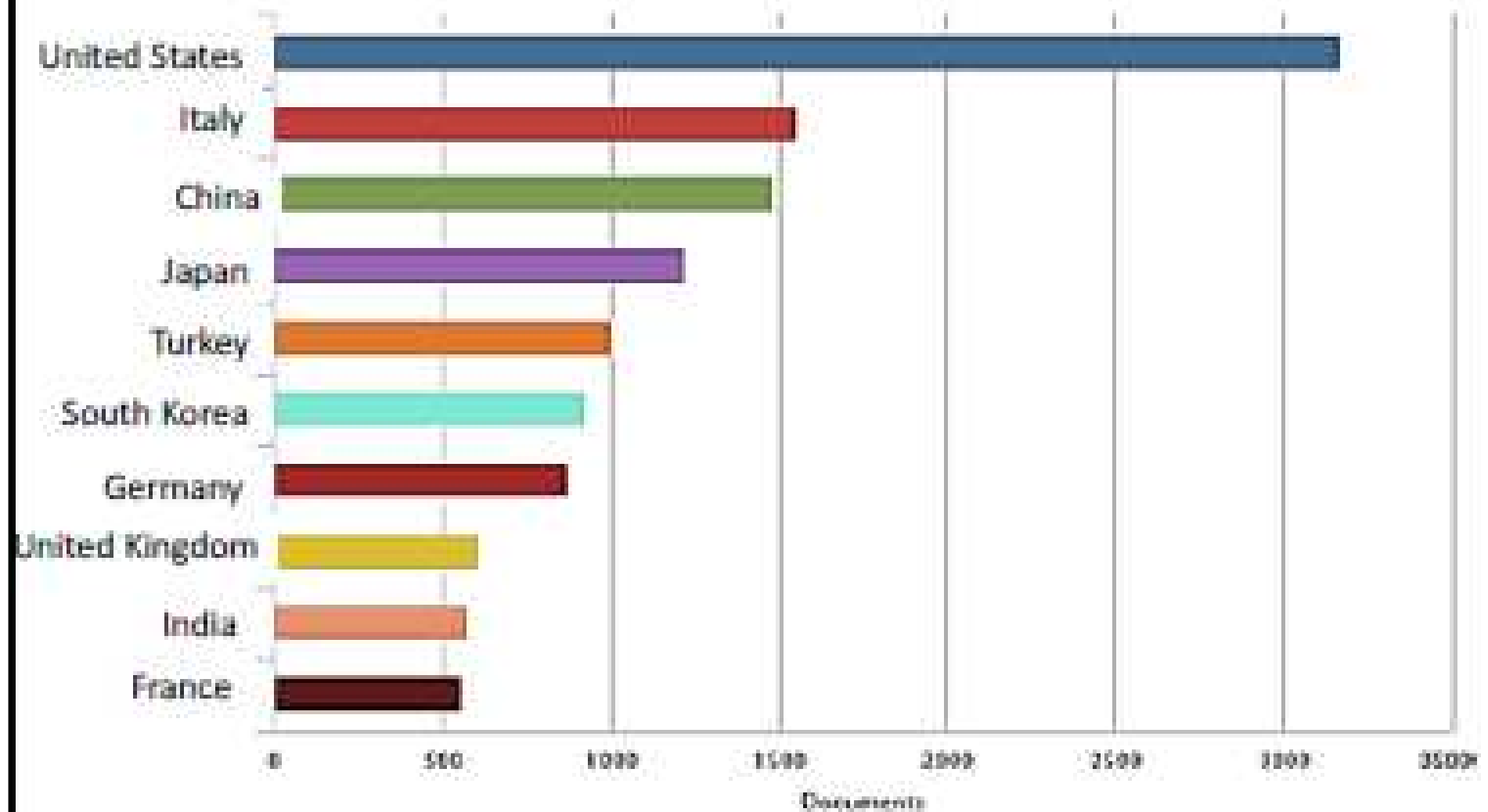

# “Bibliometrics”

- A term coined in the 1960's to refer to the analysis and quantification of “recorded information” [Source: De Bellis N. Bibliometrics and citation analysis Scarecrow Press 2009]
- For today's presentation, the “recorded information” is articles in the field of “clinical thyroid disease”, including
  - the changes in the clinical thyroid disease literature over the last decade
  - and quantification of the numbers of citations to individual articles to potentially identify the most “influential” papers
